City South Association Inc. (CSA) is an independent not-for-profit organisation, which is part funded by the Adelaide City Council.


We are dedicated to representing the interests of businesses, residents, workers, visitors and property owners within our defined precinct boundaries.

## Introducing The City South Traders

Under the working title of 'City South Traders', the new Task Group will meet bi-monthly and work exclusively on matters affecting traders in the area.

Project and strategy ideas developed by the Task Group will then be presented to the current Management Committee and once agreed upon, will be funded by the Association.



#### Suggested Goals for the Group

Initial meetings of the Group will establish Goals and Strategies, as well as its name ('City South Traders' being a working title for the moment). Suggested Goals for the Group could include:

To increase the Precinct's profile within the wider community

To increase visitation to the Precinct

To provide business networking opportunities within the Precinct

To conduct activities to promote vibrancy and participation of local business



## Suggested Strategies

#### **Business Directory Brochure**

To be distributed to Accommodation sites within the Precinct.

#### **Online Business Directory**

To be established on the City South website, with highlighted listings for City South Members

#### **Promoting Business through our Newsletter**

Articles about local business developments and openings



## Suggested Strategies

Some strategy examples are outlined below...

#### **City South & Proud Campaign**

Business Members to receive a sticker for their shopfront window, and logo for their website to create an identity for area.

This will be backed up by a public relations campaign with the aim of highlighting prominent and long-standing businesses of the Precinct.

#### **City South App**

A free App to promote businesses and sites to visit in the City South Precinct.



## Suggested Strategies

Some strategy examples are outlined below...

#### **Festival Promotion and Participation**

Look to increase the profile and participation of businesses in major Festival events such as Fringe, History Month, Umbrella and Tasting Australia

#### **Nights Out in City South**

Promotional campaign for night-time venues in the City South Precinct

#### **Lights On in City South**

A lighting project to encourage night time visitors to build on the Whitmore Square Festive Lights
