Year in Review 2023/24



Overview

- Cost of living pressures, reduced customer spending, property vacancies and issues with homelessness and crime have caused some negative sentiment around the City South Precinct over the last 12 months.
- However, we feel that City South has been able to inject some positivity into the area with some great outcomes from its activities across the year.
- The 2024 Vino & Vibes event built on the success of its debut the year before, with increased numbers, excellent feedback from venues and valuable research carried out to demonstrate its value in attracting patrons from outside of the city.
- A new approach to Business Membership and Support has meant that the Association is now actively engaging with a large number of local hospitality, retail and service businesses via Facebook and its newly setup Instagram account.
- City South has also rebranded its public facing channels from City South
 Association to City South Adelaide in an effort to strengthen the Precinct's identity.
- By concentrating on supporting as many businesses as possible, rather than just those who choose to be Members, is increasing the Association's profile and will no doubt be far more beneficial to all in the long run.




Year in Review 2023/24 - Projects



Whitmore Square Festive Lights - Nov 14 2023 to Jan 10 2024

- After last year applying for a Quick Response Grant to part finance the installation of the lights, Cr Keiran Snape advocated that the costs of 2023/24 installation be fully funded by the City of Adelaide. The Association was very grateful for this support.
- As such, the display went ahead for the Festive Season from Nov 14 2023 to Jan 10 2024 with the lights on from 8pm-2am each night.
- The display consisted of 200 metres of colour-changing LED Festoon lights attached to
 existing light poles, running North-South and East-West along the pathways. In addition to
 these were 4 large green floods highlighting the major trees on each extreme of the Square.

- . City South will continue to do this every 2-3 months, with our next one coming up this month!








Year in Review 2023/2024 - Projects

- City South aims to run an online networking session in the near future instead.








Year in Review 2023/24 - Projects

- This event presented cellar door style experiences across the Precinct with free and paid wine and spirit tastings on offer alongside live entertainment.
- 8 venues were involved on the Saturday afternoon, 7 on Sunday afternoon (up from 7 venues on Saturday last year, and only 4 on the Sunday)

We plan to run this event again in May 2025!










Year in Review 2023/24

City South Social Media

- This has helped increase traction across both social media streams and made City South Association much more visible to businesses across the Precinct.







- We have also introduced an Instagram feed onto the Home Page to help showcase the Precinct's unique features as well as local businesses.










Year in Review 2023/24

- As of June 2024, City South has changed its focus from pursuing and directing support to Member business to now taking a Precinct-wide approach to Business support and promotion.








Looking Forward 2024-25
